Florida Hospital is one of the country's largest not–for–profit health care providers. The 2,247–bed acute care medical facility is a member of the Adventist Health System, which operates 44 hospitals in ten states, making it the largest not–for–profit Protestant health care system in the U.S. The hospital was the first in the state to perform a total knee replacement and arthroscopic surgery, and they are currently ranked as the number one Medicare hospital in the country for hip and knee procedures.

In addition, the Orthopedic Institute performs more orthopedic surgeries than any other hospital in Florida.
